This full-time, permanent position reports to the Director, Development & Communications and plays a key role on the Development team.

- Managing a comprehensive fundraising portfolio that includes multiple fundraising appeals with the ability to identify new opportunities and provide strategic insight for all fundraising appeal types.

- Excellent written and oral communication skills, including interpersonal and persuasive communication, with experience in stakeholder engagement, presentations, speechwriting and public relations.
- Managing budget allocations for all annual giving appeals.
- The capacity to plan, analyze and measure results.
- A passion for contributing to a team, previous management experience and a demonstrated ability to lead staff to achieve goals.
- Experience using Raisers Edge (or similar donor database) and MS Office.
- A bachelor's degree or equivalent experience in a related field.
- Professional certification (CFRE, CFP) or equivalent experience.
- A minimum 5 years' progressive experience in a fundraising management program.
